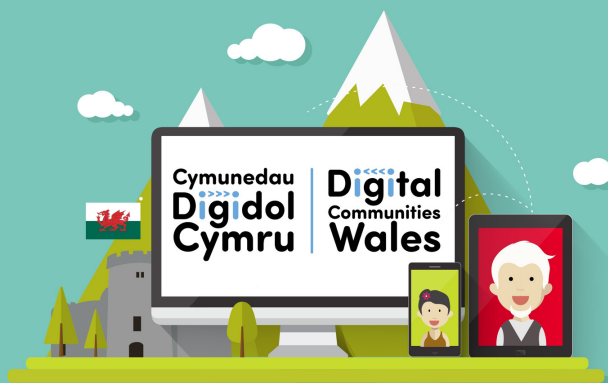


Digital Communities Wales

E-Learning

15% (400,000) of adults in Wales are not online. Digital Communities Wales along with our partners at Digital Unite have developed training for front line staff and volunteers to assist those who are digitally excluded. These courses will enable organisations to integrate digital inclusion support into their everyday activities by understanding the barriers that people face and the importance of digital inclusion.



Benefits of distance learning
